
Text - John 3:1-21

The key verse for this lesson is John 3:17 – "For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through Him."




In this 9-lesson study, children will learn about how the Holy Spirit impacts their lives. Each lesson is packed with activities and ideas to help educators teach the main idea, making it easy to adapt for any teaching situation. Whether you're looking for a curriculum that covers Galatians 5:22-23 or just want a fun way to help kids learn more about the Bible, this study is perfect for you!

Each lesson plan includes extensive teacher notes, learning activities, and printables. It's everything you need to share God's Work with the children in your class. "Jesus' Resurrection: the Proof that Christ's Death for Sin Worked is an excerpt from the "Big Truths" series entitled "The Work that Jesus Has Done." This series is designed to give kids a bigger picture of the cross and the work that Jesus Christ did on the cross.


The full 6-week series follows this outline:

- 1. Jesus' Death Showed God's Justice and Mercy Matthew 26
- 2. Jesus Paid the Full Penalty for Sin Matthew 26-27
- 3. Jesus' Victory Over Satan by His Payment for Sin Matthew 27
- 4. Jesus' Resurrection: The Proof that Christ's Death for Sin Worked Mk 16
- 5. Jesus is King Over All Isaiah 9, Philippians 2, Ezekiel 37
- 6. But is Jesus Really the Only Savior? various texts



"Honor Your Mom" is a stand-alone Mother's Day lesson for Sunday School or children's ministry. In this Bible lesson, children will learn about several Biblical moms, with a focus on the story of Ruth. In the mother's day lesson they'll see how Ruth honored God by honoring her mother-in-law, and they'll see how as the great-grandmother to King David, Ruth became one of the few moms listed in Jesus' family tree.


Children will also focus on the 5th commandment and talk about what it means to honor their mother, thank God for the gift of moms and make something they can give their mom for Mother's Day. Most importantly, in this lesson, children will see that God's children are called to obey Him, and one way we can obey God is by honoring our parents, while also seeing that on our own we cannot obey God. We need Jesus to help us obey and honor our moms!



The book of Psalms is often referred to as the Bible's songbook. In the Psalms we see a full range of emotions from the Psalmists as they worship the LORD through singing, shouting, weeping, rejoicing and more. In "Sing! Shout! Jump!" children will get a bigger picture of who God is and what it means to worship Him. Plus, they'll see how they can worship the LORD in a myriad of ways.

In this first series of "Sing! Shout! Jump!" kids will be introduced to the book of Psalms and look at the first six Psalms.

- Psalm 1 Walk in His Ways
- Psalm 2 Run to God
- Psalm 3 Cry Out to God
- Psalm 4 Lie Down and Trust God
- Psalm 5 Ask God to Deliver
- Psalm 6 Plead for Mercy



"The Greatest Dad" is a stand-alone Father's Day lesson. In this lesson, children will see the failure of several Biblical dads, while focusing in on the goodness of God the Father. The main text for the week is the genealogy of Jesus from Luke 3, focusing on the final line, "the son of God," showing how Jesus is the Son of God, not the son of Joseph. While walking through this genealogy, kids will be reminded of several fathers in the genealogy and what we know about them as fathers from the Bible.


In small groups, kids will get a chance to review what it means that Jesus is the Son of God and how all who follow Jesus can turn to God as their Father. They'll also have a chance to thank God for their earthly fathers (who hopefully point them to God the Father) and make something they can give to their dads for Father's Day.

This lesson is designed to be used on Father's Day Sunday, or during the week before Father's Day and is perfect for slotting in between other curriculum materials.



CHRISTIAN COOL explores just how cool it is to be the Christian God is calling us all to be today! Kids grades K-5 can participate in this seven-lesson study at church or at home. Through simple lessons based on Scripture, kids can discover and challenge themselves to live their faith more fully right now.

Each CHRISTIAN COOL lesson starts with the letter C [create, consider, contribute, contentment, courage, compassion, & collaborate] and offers prayer, activity, Scripture discussion questions, and a craft with supply list. Also included is a review sheet for taking home with Scripture verse to contemplate and coloring page. Through using supplies, you likely already have, and the freedom to make the lessons fit your group, kids will discover what it's like to be CHRISTIAN COOL!



The Bible is full of BIG words that can seem really intimidating to kids (and let's face it, to adults to). So, instead of skipping over them, Big Bible Words introduces those words and helps kids to make these words a part of their everyday vocabulary. In these 8 lessons, children will come face to face with words like election, faith, regeneration, conversion, justification, adoption, sanctification, perseverance, and glorification, and will see what all these words have to do with salvation.

Through these lessons, children will grow in their understanding of the work of salvation that Jesus did and see salvation as the gift that it is.

With 60-90 minutes of teaching materials, these lessons are perfect to use for Sunday School, Children's Church, mid-week discipleship times, or even as a pre or post baptism class. 

"Give Thanks" is designed to be used in a self-contained class with a wide range of age groups. This is a 'print & teach' lesson, meaning that preparation is easy (just a few photocopies) and additional supplies needed are minimal (probably things you already have in your class).




Age group: preschool- grade 6/ ages 2-12

Christmas time can be a very confusing time for children as they try and sort out the truth out of all the messages thrown at them. What is Christmas all about? Is it about the gifts? Is it about Santa? What's the real story of Christmas?

### WHAT IS IT?

Breakfast in Bethlehem is designed to be a fun family event that allows kids to experience the story of Christmas as they make their way through a series of booths. You could say that "Breakfast in Bethlehem" is a family Christmas Carnival. With a few simple supplies: a large space (gym, fellowship hall, or outside), and this guide, you're sure to have an event that kids and parents will remember forever.


During "Breakfast in Bethlehem," families will make their way through a series of booths (games, crafts, and snacks) and discover the true Christmas story a little bit at a time as they experience each of the activities. 


Age group: toddlers - elementary




